BUS RULES & TERMS

The school reserves the right to suspend the bus transport of any learner who violates the rules mentioned below.

1. No music, dancing, and/or shouting will be allowed on the bus.
2. No papers or any items must be thrown out of the bus windows.
3. The bus fee is mandatory and payable before the 7th of every month.
4. Bus fees are still paid even if it is a school holiday, except in December.
5. Learners will not be allowed to get on or off the bus except at their designated stops.
6. Learners must always adhere to the school's code of conduct. (Example. Neatness and uniform)
7. No foul language will be allowed on the bus.

Bus rules are in place for the following reasons:

- The bus driver has a great responsibility to transport learners safely. It becomes difficult if learners sing, dance, and shout on the bus.
- Throwing rubbish and objects out of the bus sends a very negative image of our school to the public.
- It is important that parents pay on time for the school to pay its suppliers. Bloemfontein High School's bus fees are still the cheapest in town. The school makes no profit by offering you transportation.
- For the safety of our learners, as well as for the bus drivers, learners will not be picked up or dropped off along the route. Only at their designated stops.

DEBAT

Bloemfontein: 'n Debat oor Wêreldklas-status

Op 1 Augustus 2024 het die skoolsaal ontplof met intellektuele ywer toe Graad 10- en Graad 11-leerders 'n geesdriftige debat gevoer oor of Bloemfontein die titel van 'n wêreldklas-stad verdien. Die onderwerp is deur verskeie lense ontleed, insluitende infrastruktuur, werksgeleenthede en universiteite, kultuur, vermaak, sport, wetstoepassing, wat passievolle argumente en insiggewende perspektiewe van beide kante opgelewer het.

Die debat, 'n hoogtepunt van die 2024 Kwartaal 3 kalender, het die welsprekendheid en analitiese vaardighede van ons leerders uitgelig terwyl hulle goed nagevorsde argumente aangebied het. Van die stad se moderne infrastruktuur en groeiende arbeidsmark tot sy lewendige kulturele toneel en uitmuntende sportprestasies, elke onderverdeling is sorgvuldig ondersoek om Bloemfontein se status as stad op die wêreldwye verhoog te bepaal.

Graad 10-leerders het die stad se infrastruktuurontwikkelings beklemtoon, en het beklemtoon hoe goed-onderhoude paaie en effektiewe openbare vervoerstelsels bydra tot sy aantrekkingskrag. DEBATE

Bloemfontein: A Debate on World-Class Status
